

## MUNICIPALITY OF BIFROST-RIVERTON

### BY-LAW 10-2017

**Being a By-law of the Municipality of Bifrost-Riverton to establish a Fire Equipment Reserve for Rural Area.**

**WHEREAS** Section 168 of *The Municipal Act* provides that a Council may by by-law establish reserve funds for any general or specific purpose;

**AND WHEREAS** the Municipality of Bifrost-Riverton By-law 14-2015, established a Rural Fire Equipment Reserve Fund which has in its account the sum of \$52,636.98;


**AND WHEREAS** it is deemed necessary and desirable to establish a Rural Fire Equipment Reserve Fund and to repeal By-law 14-2015;


**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Municipality of Bifrost-Riverton deems it expedient that a special rate to produce the amount of \$2,250 be levied annually on the assessed value of the rateable property of the Corporation liable therefore to produce an amount which shall be deposited in the Reserve hereby created and form a part thereof;

**NOW THEREFORE** the council of the Municipality of Bifrost-Riverton enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** a Rural Fire Equipment Reserve Fund be created;
2. **THAT** By-law No. 14-2015 is hereby repealed;
3. **THAT** the sum of \$52,636.98 being the proceeds from the Rural Fire Equipment Reserve Fund established under By-law 14-2015 be transferred to the Rural Fire Equipment Reserve Fund created under clause 1 above;
4. **THAT** a special rate to produce the amount of \$2,250 be and hereby is levied annually for a period of one (1) year commencing in the year 2017 upon the assessed value of the rateable property in the Corporation liable therefore to produce an amount which shall be deposited in the Reserve Fund created hereby and form a part thereof;
5. **THAT** the Corporation shall keep in its books a separate account designating the purpose for which the fund was created and showing at all times the state of the reserve fund created hereby; and
6. **THAT** if the reserve fund or any portion thereof is invested, the securities thereof shall be earmarked and kept separate from other securities of the Corporation.
