

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BIFROST

BY-LAW NO. 2-88

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Bifrost for the purpose of amending By-Law No. 8-87 which was passed for the purpose of preventing or regulating the firing or use of firearms within the municipality.

WHEREAS "The Municipal Act" of Manitoba provides as follows:

"Section 183(5) An existing by-law may be amended or repealed by another by-law; but a by-law that has been approved by the board or has been submitted to, and been approved by a vote of the electors, or resident electors, shall not thereafter be amended or repealed unless the proposed amending or repealing by-law is, in like manner approved by the board, and if required by the board, by a vote of the electors, as the case may be."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Bifrost now deems this to be an expedient time to amend By-Law No. 8-87 by revising and clarifying several of the paragraphs therein;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Bifrost, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That Section 2.(a) of By-Law No. 8-87 be deleted and replaced with the following:
- 2.(a) "High Powered Rifle" means any rifle that fires projectiles by means of a centre fire explosive
2. That Section 3.(1) of By-Law No. 8-87 be amended by replacing the word "firearm" with the words "high powered rifle"
3. That Section 3.(2) Subsection (c) be deleted and replaced with the following:
(c) licenced trappers
